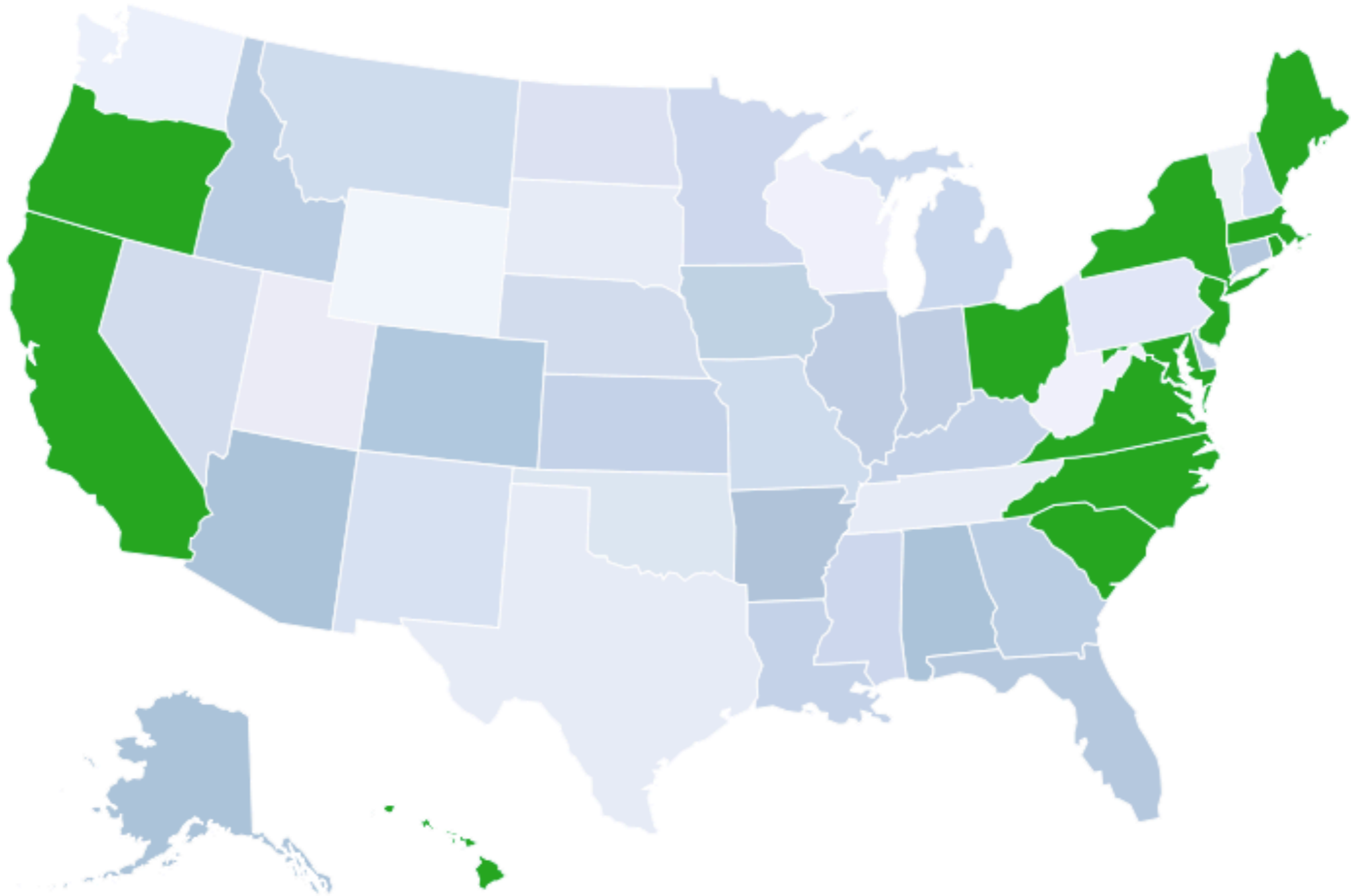
## **About the Network**
