



Transportation – Philadelphia/Atlantic City

SEPTA – Regional Train – Airport Line

The “Airport line” between Philadelphia International Airport and Center City runs seven days a week from 5:00 AM to midnight with trains every 30 minutes on weekdays and every hour on weekends and holidays. **The trip between the airport and 30th Street Station is about 20 minutes.**

Amtrak – Philadelphia Center City - 30th Street Station - Atlantic City Rail Line

The Atlantic City Rail Line offers convenient daily service from Philadelphia 30th Street Station to Atlantic City Rail Terminal. [Book your trip ticket](#) for travel to and from any Amtrak train station.

From Philadelphia, the trip takes about 90 minutes. You can also board Atlantic City Line trains in Pennsauken, Cherry Hill, Lindenwold, Atco, Hammonton, Egg Harbor City and Absecon.

Arrival in Atlantic City

In Atlantic City, Convenient shuttle bus service and taxis are available between the Atlantic City Rail Terminal and casinos and hotels. Shuttle pickups at casinos and hotels begin approximately 30 minutes before the train is scheduled to depart.
