Each scholarship award will be for a total of \$5,000, which must be used toward tuition fees.

ELIGIBILITY & CRITERIA

- A high school student currently in their senior year (class of 2023) intending to enroll full time in a two or four-year college or university beginning fall 2023
- Demonstrates excellent academic achievement and community service
- Involvement in school projects related to any aspect of offshore wind energy, and/or an internship working with companies involved the offshore wind industry
- Applicants will be judged by academic industry leaders and Network Board members based on their interest in pursuing a career in offshore wind, academic achievement, and financial need
